Title IX (1972) — "No person in the U.S. shall, on the basis of sex be excluded from participation in, or denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any educational program or activity receiving federal aid." (Section 1681. Sex)

- Gender Discrimination
- Retaliation for reporting acts of discrimination listed above
- If you or someone you know at Creighton has experienced any of the covered behaviors, you have the right to file an internal complaint with the University
